



Seaport Next Generation (NxG) IDIQ

Mission

The Seaport-NxG contracting vehicle provides support to the Department of the Navy (DON) as the **mandatory** vehicle for all professional support services. Seaport-NxG refers to an indefinite delivery indefinite quantity (IDIQ) multiple award contract (MAC) and also an electronic platform to solicit, award and administer task orders.

Overview

The DON Systems Commands (NAVSEA, NAVAIR, NAVWAR, NAVFAC and NAVSUP), ONR, MSC and USMC compete their support service requirements amongst Seaport-NxG IDIQ MAC holders. The Seaport-NxG portal provides a standardized, efficient means of soliciting offers from amongst the diverse population of large and small businesses and their approved team members.

LinQuest Corporation is proud to be a prime contractor on Seaport-NxG. LinQuest has provided Program Management/Acquisition support, Systems Engineering, Training, Modeling and Simulation and Integrated Logistics Support on the Seaport-e and now Seaport NxG contracts.

All task orders are competitively solicited, awarded and administered using the Seaport-NxG portal. The Seaport-NxG contract scope includes Engineering, Technical and Professional Support Services across 23 functional service areas. Seaport NxG uses a fully electronic Task Order Process (including electronic signature) - From the desktop, managers can initiate a Task Order, accept and evaluate proposals and award a task order through the web-based Seaport portal.

Seaport-NxG has a \$20B ceiling, with a five-year base ordering period and five-year optional ordering period, ending in December 2029. Awarded task orders can have their POP extend beyond the end of the ordering period for up to five years. The Seaport-NxG Program Management Office (PMO) does not charge a fee for using the contract.

Seaport-NxG Prime Contractor Overview

Seaport-NxG is the premier contract vehicle for procurements supporting the NAVSEA mission "to design, build, deliver, and maintain ships and systems on time and on cost for the United States Navy." This contract underpins their priorities and aligns directly with the Navy's "Design for Maintaining Maritime Superiority".
